EXPLANATORY NOTES

You are being reported because the issuing officer believes there is sufficient evidence to prosecute you for a road traffic offence(s).

For certain offences you may be eligible for a National Driver Offender Retraining Course as an alternative to a fixed penalty or summons depending on the offence. Your previous offending record (if any) and any previous course you have attended or are waiting to attend as a result of committing another offence will be taken into account.

If you are deemed to be eligible for a course the Metropolitan Police will confirm this in writing.

The Metropolitan Police are under no obligation to offer you a course and if they do it is a concession by the Commissioner. The Metropolitan Police are also at liberty to withdraw a course offer at any time up to the point that you have successfully completed a course.

If you are not eligible for a course or elect not to attend a course you will receive a conditional offer of a fixed penalty and will be required to pay the appropriate fine and to submit your driving licence for penalty points (where applicable).

OR

A Summons may be issued for the original offence.

DO NOT do anything until you receive communication about this matter from the Metropolitan Police Service. We will not be able to deal with your query until this point.

The Metropolitan Police Service is committed to reducing the number of people killed and seriously injured on our roads and participates in the National Driver Retraining Scheme, seeking to educate rather than prosecute. You may benefit from attending a course as an alternative to a fixed penalty or summons.
