

Notice for a misconduct hearing to be held in public from 20th February to 1st March 2019

Police Sergeant Sidney Rogers, based at NE-CU will answer allegations that his conduct amounted to a breach of the Standards of Professional Behaviour in respect of:

Duties and Responsibilities

Honesty and Integrity

Police Constable Adrian Brown (based at MO2 - Met Intelligence) and Police Constable Christopher Moore (based at EA-CU - East Area Basic Command Unit) face allegations that their conduct amounted to breaches of the Standards of Professional Behaviour in respect of:

Authority, Respect and Courtesy

Orders and Instructions

Duties and Responsibilities

Honesty and Integrity

On 30th July 2013, PS Rogers had a telephone conversation with a male known as "GK". GK was the ex-boyfriend of a female known as "LK".

It is alleged that during this conversation, PS Rogers agreed GK could attend LK's home address without police being present.

Given the intelligence available at the time, it is alleged that PS Rogers should have explicitly advised against this.

It is further alleged that PS Rogers gave dishonest accounts when later questioned about his actions.

On 29th July 2013, LK called police to make allegations against GK. In responding to these calls, PC Brown and PC Moore attended LK's home address.

It is alleged that PC Brown and PC Moore did not conduct an adequate investigation and failed to record relevant evidence. It is further alleged that they failed to conduct adequate arrest enquiries in relation to GK.

Finally, it is alleged that the officers gave dishonest accounts in relation to the above.

It is alleged that Police Sergeant Rogers breached the Standards of Professional Behaviour in respect of Duties and Responsibilities and Honesty and Integrity.

Police Constable Brown and Police Constable Moore are alleged to have breached the Standards of Professional Behaviour in respect of Authority, Respect and Courtesy, Orders and Instructions, Duties and Responsibilities and Honesty and Integrity.

The hearing will start on Wednesday 20th February and is listed for eight days.

It will be held from 0930 hours in the DPS Tribunal Rooms, 14th Floor, Empress State Building, Lillie Road, SW6 1TR.
