The officers will answer allegations that their conduct amounted to a Breach of the Standards of Professional Behaviour, in respect of:

On 21st August 2008 the officers were involved in the arrest and detention of Sean Rigg;

It is alleged that Police Constable Birks has breached the Standards of Professional Behaviour in relation to Duties and Responsibilities.

It is alleged that Police Constable Glasson has breached the standards of Professional Behaviour in relation to Honesty and Integrity, Use of Force and Abuse of Authority and Duties and Responsibilities.

It is alleged that Police Constable Forward has breached the standards of Professional Behaviour in relation to Honesty and Integrity, Use of Force and Abuse of Authority and Duties and Responsibilities.

It is alleged that Police Constable Harratt has breached the standards of Professional Behaviour in relation to Honesty and Integrity, Use of Force and Abuse of Authority and Duties and Responsibilities.

It is alleged that Police Sergeant White has breached the standards of Professional Behaviour in relation to Honesty and Integrity and Duties and Responsibilities.

The hearing will start on Monday 21st January 2019 and is listed for 6 weeks. It will be held from 09:30hrs in the hearing room, 14th Floor, Empress State Building, Lillie Road, SW6.
